STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to increase the salary of the Judge of the
Municipal Court for the city of Lewiston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter six hundred
2 and thirty-six of the private and special laws of
3 eighteen hundred and seventy-one, as since
4 amended, entitled "An Act to establish a munici-
5 pal Court in the city of Lewiston," is hereby fur-
6 ther amended by striking out the words "twelve
7 hundred," in the eighth line of said section as
8 amended, and inserting instead the words 'fifteen

9 hundred,' so that said section as hereby amended,
10 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. A municipal court is hereby estab-
12 lished for the city of Lewiston, which shall be a
13 court of record, and have a seal, and shall consist
14 of one judge, who shall be a member of the bar in
15 Androscoggin county, who shall be appointed,
16 elected, qualified, and hold his office as provided in
17 the constitution, who shall reside during his con-
18 tinuance in office in said city of Lewiston, and
19 who shall receive from said city, in monthly pay-
20 ments, an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars,
21 which shall be in full for all fees pertaining to his
22 office.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
