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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

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AN ACT to prevent the use of narrow rimmed  
wheels for the hauling of hides, leather, silica, lum-  
ber or timber over the roads or streets of Cherryfield,  
Milbridge, Deblois or Beddington.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall haul or  
2 cart hides, leather, silica, lumber or timber over the  
3 roads or streets of the towns of Cherryfield, Mil-  
4 bridge, Deblois or Beddington, with a team of three  
5 (3) or more horses, mules or oxen, upon wheels of  
6 less than five (5) inches tread or breadth of rim, nor

7 with a team of two (2) horses, mules or oxen upon  
8 wheels of less than four (4) inches tread or breadth  
9 of rim.

SECT. 2. If any person shall violate the provisions  
2 of the foregoing section, he shall pay a fine of ten  
3 (10) dollars for every such offence, with costs of  
4 prosecution to be enforced before any court of com-  
5 petent jurisdiction, one-half of said fine to go to  
6 the complainant and one-half to the County of  
7 Washington.

SECT. 3. Trial justices of Cherryfield, Milbridge,  
2 Deblois or Beddington shall have jurisdiction for  
3 the trial of offences against the provisions of this  
4 act in the same manner, and to the same extent as  
5 if not residents of said towns.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect and be in  
2 force from and after the first day of May in the year  
3 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-  
4 one.
