STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred fifteen of the Revised Statutes entitled "Salaries of Public Officers and compensation of Members of the Government."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of said Chapter is

- 2 hereby amended in that paragraph which provides
- 3 for the salary of the Secretary of the Board of
- 4 Agriculture by striking out the word "six," and
- 5 inserting in lieu thereof the word 'fifteen,' so that
- 6 said paragraph shall read as follows:

'The secretary of the board of agriculture, fifteen 8 hundred dollars, and reimbursement for necessary 9 expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties, 10 an account whereof shall be first audited by the 11 Governor and council, who from time to time may 12 draw their warrants on the treasurer of state for 13 such sums as are necessary to defray the same and 14 other expenses provided for in chapter fifty-eight.
