STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act to authorize the erection and maintenance of a sluice at Upper Stillwater."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section two of said Act is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out from the second line
- 3 thereof the words "Board measure Bangor survey"
- 4 and inserting instead the words 'purchase scale',
- 5 so that said section two as amended shall read as
- 6 follows:
- 'Sect. 2. Said corporation may demand and 8 receive a toll of two cents per thousand feet, pur-

9 chase scale, on all logs and lumber passing through 10 the same, and shall have a lien on all such logs 11 and lumber for payment of the tolls. The toll 12 shall be payable at such time and place as the 13 directors may determine, and if not so paid, said 14 corporation may take and sell at public auction, 15 after ten days' public notice, so many of the logs 16 as is necessary to pay said tolls.'
