STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the County Attorney
of the County of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. On and after the first day of Janu-
2 ary in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight
3 hundred and ninety-one, the salary of the county
4 attorney of Washington county shall be five hun-
5 dred (500) dollars per annum, payable in quarterly
6 payments, instead of the sum now established by
7 law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
