STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize F. A. Hutchins, Nelson Thompson and their associates to build and maintain a wharf in the tide waters of Friendship, Knox County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. F. A. Hutchins, Nelson Thompson, 2 their associates or assigns are hereby authorized to 3 erect and maintain a wharf on the southeast side of 4 Martin's Point into the tide waters of Hatchet Cove 5 in the town of Friendship, county of Knox.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
