STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings by which
Lincoln Plantation was organized.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The proceedings by which Lincoln
2 Plantation in Oxford county was organized on the
3 fifteenth (15th) day of September, eighteen hundred
4 and seventy-five, are hereby confirmed, and the
5 organization of said plantation is hereby declared
6 legal and valid.
