STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT for the Protection of Fish in the tributaries
of Wilson pond in the city of Auburn, Andros-
coggin county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No fish of any kind shall be taken
2 from the tributaries of Wilson pond in the city of
3 Auburn, county of Androscoggin, in any manner
4 for the period of six years, except for the purposes
5 of propagation, under the direction of the Fishery
6 Commissioners.

SECT. 2. The penalty for violation of this act
2 shall be a fine of not less than five dollars nor more

3 than fifteen dollars for each fish so taken, to be
4 recovered on complaint before the municipal court
5 for the city of Auburn, one-half to the complainant
6 and one-half to the county of Androscoggin.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on and after
2 February twenty-first, A. D. 1891.
