STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 225 of the Private and
Special Laws of 1887, in relation to the organiza-
tion of the Sagadahoc real estate association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Said chapter is amended by striking
2 out the words "for said purposes" in the first line
3 of section 2 of said act, also the word "one" before
4 "hundred" in the second line of said section and
5 insert the word 'ten' in place thereof, so that as
6 amended said section shall read as follows :

‘Section 2. Said corporation may hold real and
8 personal estate not exceeding in amount ten hundred
9 thousand dollars.’

SECT. 2. The third section of said chapter is
2 amended by striking out the words “shall be thirty-
3 five” before thousand in the second line and insert-
4 ing ‘shall not exceed five hundred,’ also by striking
5 out all after the word “each” in said third section; so
6 that when amended said third section shall read as
7 follows:

‘Section 3. The capital stock of this corporation
9 shall not exceed five hundred thousand dollars.’

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when
2 approved.
