STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the Revised Statutes relating to salaries.


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred

- 2 and fifteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out lines fifty-three, fifty-
- 4 four, fifty-five, fifty-six and fifty-seven and insert-
- 5 ing instead thereof the following:

Four assistant superintendents, one of whom 7 shall be a female, such sum as the trustees may

- 8 from time to time vote, not exceeding thirty-two
- 9 hundred dollars a year for the four; the steward,
- 10 including his duties as treasurer, such sum as the
- 11 trustees may from time to time vote, not exceeding
- 12 twelve hundred dollars in full for all services;
- 13 chaplain three hundred dollars; matron four hun-
- 14 dred dollars.'
 - SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
 - 2 with this act are hereby repealed.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect January one
 - 2 eighteen hundred and ninety-one.
