STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-four thousand 2 and five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts for the 5 years eighteen hundred and ninety-one and 6 eighteen hundred and ninety-two to be expended 7 as follows: Amount to be used to erect new building to replace Wingate Hall sixteen thousand 9 dollars; to erect foundry building eight hundred 10 dollars; for cases in Coburn Hall department of 11 natural history six hundred dollars; to construct

12 dairy building two thousand and five hundred 13 dollars; to erect tool shed five hundred dollars; 14 for stand-pipe for fire protection three thousand 15 and six hundred dollars; for hose and carriage 16 five hundred dollars; and the full amount hereby 17 appropriated for the above named purposes shall 18 be payable during the year eighteen hundred and 19 ninety-one. Provided, however, that each of the 20 several sums hereinbefore mentioned shall be used 21 for the respective purposes specified in this resolve 22 and for no other.
