RESOLVE in favor of a road in Franklin County
from Rangeley to Eustis.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand five
2 hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated in
3 aid of building a road from the town of Rangeley
4 through Dallas Plantation, Lang Plantation and
5 Coplin Plantation to the town of Eustis in Franklin
6 county, to be expended under the direction of the
7 county commissioners of said county.
