AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT No. 43.

Amend by striking out all after the enacting clause and insert the following.

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter fifty-five of the
2 Revised Statutes be amended by adding in the seventh
3 line after the words "Sovereigns of Industry" the words
4 'as a Grand Army post,' so that said section as amended
5 shall read as follows :

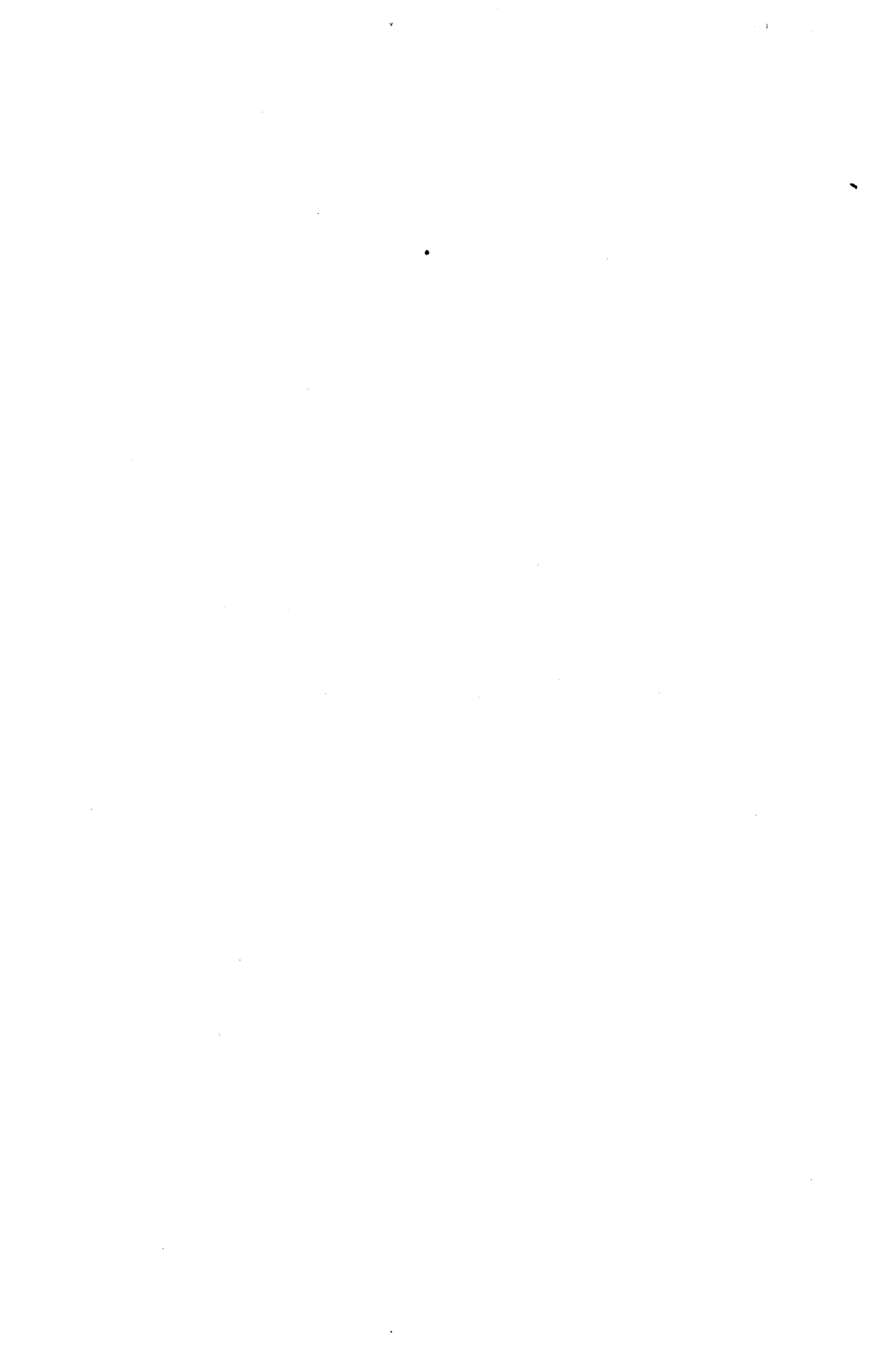
'Section 1. When seven or more persons desire to be
7 incorporated as proprietors of a social, military, literary,
8 scientific, or county law library ; as a Masonic lodge or
9 chapter of any order or degree ; as lodge of the Independ-
10 ent Order of Odd Fellows, as a division of the Sons of
11 Temperance, as a tent of Rechabites ; as a grange of
12 Patrons of Husbandry ; as a council of the Sovereigns of

13 Industry ; as a Grand Army post ; as a relief or benefit
14 association for mutual assistance ; as a monument or memo-
15 rial association ; as a society to promote temperance ; or
16 for any literary, scientific, musical, charitable, educational,
17 social, military, agricultural, moral, religious, or benevo-
18 lent purpose ; they may apply in writing to any justice of
19 the peace in the county, who may issue his warrant
20 directed to one of said applicants, requiring him to call a
21 meeting thereof at such time and place as the justice
22 appoints.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by
2 the governor.

Amendment “A” adopted.
