STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and twelve of chapter eleven of the Revised Statutes, relating to Normal Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one hundred and twelve of

- 2 chapter eleven of the Revised Statutes is hereby
- 3 amended in the first line thereof by substituting
- 4 for the word "nineteen" the words 'twenty-four,'
- 5 so that said section as amended shall read:

'Section 112. For support of the three normal 7 schools twenty-four thousand dollars is annually

- 8 appropriated, to be expended under the direction
- 9 of said trustees, which sum the treasurer of State
- 10 shall deduct for said purpose from any school
- 11 money raised for the support of common schools.
- 12 The governor and council may, from time to time,
- 13 as they think proper, draw warrants therefor on
- 14 said treasurer in favor of said trustees.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
