STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the inhabitants of the Town of Bristol to construct and maintain a Bridge across the tide waters of Rutherford's Island Gut.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The inhabitants of the town of Bris-

- 2 tol are hereby authorized to construct and maintain
- 3 a bridge over the tide waters of "Rutherford's
- 4 Island Gut," so-called, in the town of Bristol, to
- 5 extend from the southerly shore of the mainland to
- 6 the northerly shore of said Rutherford's Island, of
- 7 such width and at such point as they may consider
- 8 most practicable.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
