STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Lincoln.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be and hereby
2 is directed to pay to the treasurer of the town of
3 Lincoln in the county of Penobscot, the sum of
4 twenty dollars, the same being the amount paid by
5 said treasurer for bounty on bears, and not refunded
6 by the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The treasurer of the town of Lincoln paid the amount of this resolve for bounty on bears in the year of 1886 ; but the vouchers for same were destroyed by fire which burned his store and contents in the same year, and this appropriation is asked to re-imburse him for said amount.
