RESOLVE in aid of the Town of Cutler.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appro-2 priated the sum of five hundred dollars in aid of 3 building a road in the town of Cutler.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

We the undersigned, all citizens of the town of Cutler in the county of Washington respectfully ask that we may have an appropriation out of the funds of the State to the amount two thousand dollars, \$2,000 to aid said town in liquidating its indebtedness accrued in building a county road from Whiting to Cutler Village, distance about seven miles, in addition with thirty miles of county and town roads which we have to support for public travel, which are in bad condition at the present time with a loss of two bridges which have been carried away by tide water in the recent gale of January, 1891.
