AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT concerning Boomage Rights at Rumford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter 124 of the
2 private and special laws of 1887, entitled "An Act
3 concerning boomage rights at Rumford," are hereby
4 revived and re-enacted.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
