STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend an act allowing annual stipend to the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 108 of private 2 and special laws of 1870, is hereby amended by 3 striking out the words "one hundred and thirty" in 4 the fifth line, and inserting instead thereof the 5 words 'two hundred and fifty,' so that said section 6 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The treasurer of state is hereby 8 authorized and directed to pay to the treasurer of

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9 the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society a 10 sum equal to the sum raised by said society, the 11 year preceding the appropriation. *Provided*, the 12 same does not exceed two hundred and fifty dol-13 lars, and the same sum shall be paid annually there-14 after when said society shall have made the proper 15 returns and otherwise complied with the laws per-16 taining to such societies.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
