
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of the clerk of courts in Kennebec county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The clerk of courts of Kennebec
- 2 county shall be allowed attendance the same as pro-
- 3 vided for clerks in other counties by chapter three
- 4 hundred and sixty-five of the Public Laws of eigh-
- 5 teen hundred and eighty-five.
- SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
