STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to Inland Fisheries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Citizens of the State, during the
2 months of May and November of each year, may
3 fish for and take white fish with set nets in the
4 Schodic lakes and their tributaries, and convey the
5 same to their own homes, but not otherwise.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
