STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to fix the compensation of the Sheriff of the
county of Sagadahoc.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The sheriff of the county of Sagada-
2 hoc, from and after the first day of January, one
3 thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, shall re-
4 ceive an annual salary of three hundred dollars in
5 quarterly payments on the first day of January,
6 April, July and October instead of the compensa-
7 tion provided in section twenty-three of chapter

8 eighty of the Revised Statutes, and it is further
9 provided that the sheriff of said county shall not
10 receive from any of his deputies any of the fees
11 earned by said deputies or any percentage thereon
12 after said date.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
