RESOLVE in relation to the Public Lots in the
plantation of Highland, Somerset County.

Resolved, That the land agent be requested to
2 bring suit or otherwise take measures to test the
3 question whether the said plantation of Highland
4 owns the public lot bounded on the west by the
5 west line of said plantation of Highland for school
6 purposes, as set off by John Pierce, G. W. Clark
7 and Luke S. Mantu, as by their plan dated, Nov.
8 10, 1847, in said Highland.
