IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to repeal sections five, six, seven and eight  
of chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes, relating to  
Bounties on Wolves and Bears.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Sections five, six, seven and eight  
2 of the Revised Statutes, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
