STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and
twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to
Malicious Mischief.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Whoever wilfully or maliciously
2 drives or causes to be driven into any log or logs
3 intended to be sawed or manufactured, any nail,
4 spike, bolt, or other article such as is likely to
5 cause injury to or destruction of any saw or instru-
6 ment used in the manufacture of such logs, or
7 endanger the life or person of any one engaged in

8 such manufacture, shall be punished by fine not
9 less than one hundred dollars or more than five
10 hundred dollars, and imprisonment for not less
11 than one year or more than five years; and shall
12 also be liable to any person injured in an action on
13 the case for double the damages sustained by such
14 person.
