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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of the State Reform School.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of forty-five thousand  
2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in  
3 behalf of the State Reform School for the years  
4 eighteen hundred and ninety-one and eighteen  
5 hundred and ninety-two for the following pur-  
6 poses: For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
7 one, for current expenses, including mechanical  
8 school and new cottage, eighteen thousand dollars;  
9 for ordinary repairs, two thousand dollars; for  
10 furnishing new cottage, two thousand five hun-  
11 dred dollars; for steam heating and plumbing two

12 thousand five hundred dollars. For the year  
13 eighteen hundred and ninety-two, for current  
14 expenses, including mechanical school and new  
15 cottage, eighteen thousand dollars; for ordinary  
16 repairs, two thousand dollars. And of the above  
17 named amount twenty-five thousand dollars, or so  
18 much thereof as is necessary for the above named  
19 purposes, shall be payable in the year eighteen hun-  
20 dred and ninety-one; and twenty thousand dollars,  
21 or so much thereof as is necessary for the above  
22 named purposes, in the year eighteen hundred and  
23 ninety-two.
