STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter sixty-seven, section thirty-five of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Adoption of Children.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That chapter 67, section 35 of the Revised 2 Statutes be amended by adding at the end of said 3 section as follows:

'In case of the death of such adopted child before 5 arriving at the age of twenty-one years unmarried 6 and without issue, all property which such child 7 shall have received by virtue of such adoption, in

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8 whatever form it may then be, and not expended for

9 his or her support, shall descend the same as if 10 such child were the child by birth of his adopters.'
