STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT explanatory of Chapter 285 of the Public Laws of 1889, relating to sewers, as applicable to the town of Skowhegan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and eighty-2 five of the public laws of 1889, entitled "An Act to 3 regulate the construction of mains and common 4 sewers," shall be construed as applying to any and 5 all sewers constructed in the town of Skowhegan 6 within three years before the approval of said act. SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
