STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT explanatory of Chapter 285 of the Public
Laws of 1889, relating to sewers, as applicable to
the town of Skowhegan.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and eighty-
2 five of the public laws of 1889, entitled "An Act to
3 regulate the construction of mains and common
4 sewers," shall be construed as applying to any and
5 all sewers constructed in the town of Skowhegan
6 within three years before the approval of said act.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
