STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT concerning Public Drains in the town of Eden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Abutters upon the line of a public drain, and the 2 owners of contiguous private drains, in the town 3 of Eden, may enter and connect with it any drain 4 from any building or cellar, on written application 5 to the municipal officers of said Eden, distinctly 6 describing the building or cellar to which it applies, 7 and paying therefor what they determine. They

8 shall then give the applicant written permits to 9 enter said drain and drain the buildings and cellar 10 so described, only, which shall be available to the 11 owner of the building and cellar so described, his 12 heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, with-13 out any other subsequent permits, charge or pay-14 ment.

Said officers shall establish such other regulations 16 and conditions for entering public drains as they 17 deem expedient.

All of chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes, 19 except section four of said chapter, shall be appli-20 cable to said town of Eden.
