STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to chapter
two hundred and eighty-three of the Private and
Special Laws of A. D. 1887, entitled an Act to
Incorporate the Waldo and Somerset Railway
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Said Somerset and Waldo Railway
2 Company is hereby authorized to change and
3 abandon its location heretofore made in the town of
4 Pittsfield in the county of Somerset, and in lieu

5 thereof to locate such portion of their railroad in
6 the town of Clinton in the county of Kennebec.
7 Such change of location shall in no way affect the
8 other locations of said railroad.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said Somerset and
2 Waldo Railway Company is hereby fixed at fifty
3 thousand dollars, instead of the sum now fixed by
4 law.
