STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to Fraternal Beneficiary Organizations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any fraternal beneficiary corporation, association 2 or society organized under the laws of another 3 state issuing benefit certificates payable at stated 4 periods of equal length aggregating in the whole 5 not less than twenty-eight years and also payable 6 at death to any beneficiary therein named, may be 7 licensed by the insurance commissioner to do

- 8 business within this State upon complying with
- 9 section six of chapter two hundred and thirty-four
- 10 of the laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.
