STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT granting permission to Arthur Hegan and
others to construct a bridge across the Little Marsh
River in Prospect and Frankfort.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Permission is hereby granted to Arthur Hegan
2 and others to construct and maintain a bridge across
3 south branch stream of Marsh river in the towns of
4 Prospect and Frankfort, said bridge to cross said
5 stream at a point to the south of and near Frank
6 Goodwin's quarry wharf in the town of Prospect
7 and striking Frankfort at some convenient point
8 south of Misquito Mountain canal.
