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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

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AN ACT to amend section eighty-four of chapter  
two of the Revised Statutes, relating to the State  
Library.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section eight-four of chapter two of the Revised  
2 Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as fol-  
3 lows:

‘Section 84. The state librarian, under the direc-  
5 tion of the governor, may transmit to each depart-  
6 ment of the United States, to the several libraries  
7 of each state and territory and to any foreign state

8 three copies of all the acts and resolves published  
9 by order of the legislature, and one copy of all  
10 public documents printed and bound by like order  
11 and one copy of the printed decisions of the  
12 supreme judicial court.'
