STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-four of chapter two of the Revised Statutes, relating to the State Library.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eight-four of chapter two of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as fol-3 lows:

'Section 84. The state librarian, under the direc-

- 5 tion of the governor, may transmit to each depart-
- 6 ment of the United States, to the several libraries
- 7 of each state and territory and to any foreign state

- 8 three copies of all the acts and resolves published
- 9 by order of the legislature, and one copy of all
- 10 public documents printed and bound by like order
- 11 and one copy of the printed decisions of the
- 12 supreme judicial court.'
