STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the jurisdiction of municipal and police courts in Actions of Replevin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter ninety-six 2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding 3 thereto the following words, to wit: 'The action 4 may be brought before any municipal or police court 5 in said county, if the value of the goods does not 6 exceed the amount to which the civil jurisdiction of 7 such court is limited,' so that said section as

8 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 9. If the value of the goods exceeds 10 twenty dollars, the action shall be brought in the 11 supreme judicial or superior court for the county 12 where they are detained; if it does not exceed 13 twenty dollars, before any trial justice of said 14 county. The action may be brought before any 15 municipal or police court in said county, if the 16 value of the goods does not exceed the amount to 17 which the civil jurisdiction of such court is limited.'
