STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company to issue preferred stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Bangor and Aroostook Railroad 2 Company is hereby authorized and empowered to 3 make and issue preferred stock to an amount not 4 exceeding six hundred thousand dollars, in addition 5 to the amount of the capital stock of said company 6 provided for in the articles of association of, and the 7 certificate issued by the secretary of state to said

- 8 company as provided in chapter fifty-one of the 9 Revised Statutes, and in addition to the preferred 10 stock which said company is authorized and em11 powered to make and issue to Aroostook county;
 12 but the dividend to be paid on the preferred stock
 13 which may be issued to Aroostook county shall be
 14 paid before any dividend is paid on the preferred
 15 stock authorized to be issued by this act.
- SECT. 2. The holders of the preferred stock 2 authorized to be issued by this act shall not be 3 entitled to vote upon said stock in stockholders' 4 meeting, unless said company shall otherwise determine before the issuance of said stock.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
