STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to Labels and Trade Marks of
Unions and Associations of Workingmen.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The provisions of sections thirty-seven to forty-
2 three, inclusive, of chapter thirty-nine of the Re-
3 vised Statutes are hereby made applicable to labels
4 and trade-marks of unions and associations of
5 workingmen. The certificate therein named shall
6 be signed and sworn to by the treasurer of such
7 union or association for and in behalf of such union

8 or association. Such treasurer, upon vote of such
9 union or association, may in his own name com-
10 mence and prosecute for the use and benefit of such
11 union or association the action named in section
12 forty-one of said chapter, and all sums recovered
13 in any such action shall be the property of such
14 union or association.
