STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for furnishing
certain rooms assigned to State Officers.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-seven hundred
2 dollars and seventy-six cents be and is hereby ap-
3 propriated to provide for furnishing certain rooms
4 assigned to the State officers, to be expended as
5 follows:

For cases in Adjutant General's office, eight hun-
7 dred fifty dollars.

For case in Pension Agent's office, two hundred
9 dollars.

For furniture, cases, desks, etc., in Insurance
11 Commissioner's office, five hundred fifty dollars.

For two sofas in Senate chamber, two hundred
13 dollars.

For thirty umbrella stands, one hundred five dol-
15 lars.

For House post office and messengers room, one
17 hundred thirteen dollars and seventy cents.

For wire guards over sky-lights, two hundred fif-
19 teen dollars and nine cents.

For iron ladder for vault in treasurer's office,
21 twenty-six dollars ninety-seven cents.

For shelves, desk, cases, mats and plumbing,
23 State board of health's office, three hundred
24 seventy-five dollars.

For five tables for committee rooms, sixty-five
26 dollars.
