STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to make valid the several town meetings in
the town of Cape Elizabeth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The annual March meetings in the
2 town of Cape Elizabeth, for the years eighteen
3 hundred and eighty-eight, eighteen hundred and
4 eighty-nine and eighteen hundred and ninety, are
5 hereby made as legal and valid, as said meetings
6 would have been if all the notices of said meetings
7 had been given which were required by a former
8 vote of the town.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
