STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend an act to provide for the election
of a School Committee and a Superintendent of
Schools in Bath approved March 17th, 1891.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section four of an act entitled "An
2 Act to provide for the election of a school com-
3 mittee and superintendent of schools in Bath,"
4 approved March 17th, 1891, is hereby amended so
5 as to read as follows:

'Section 4. This act shall take effect when
7 approved, and accepted by the city of Bath. The

8 first election of school committee hereunder may
9 be had in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
10 one at a special election to be called and held in the
11 same manner that annual municipal elections are
12 called and held.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
