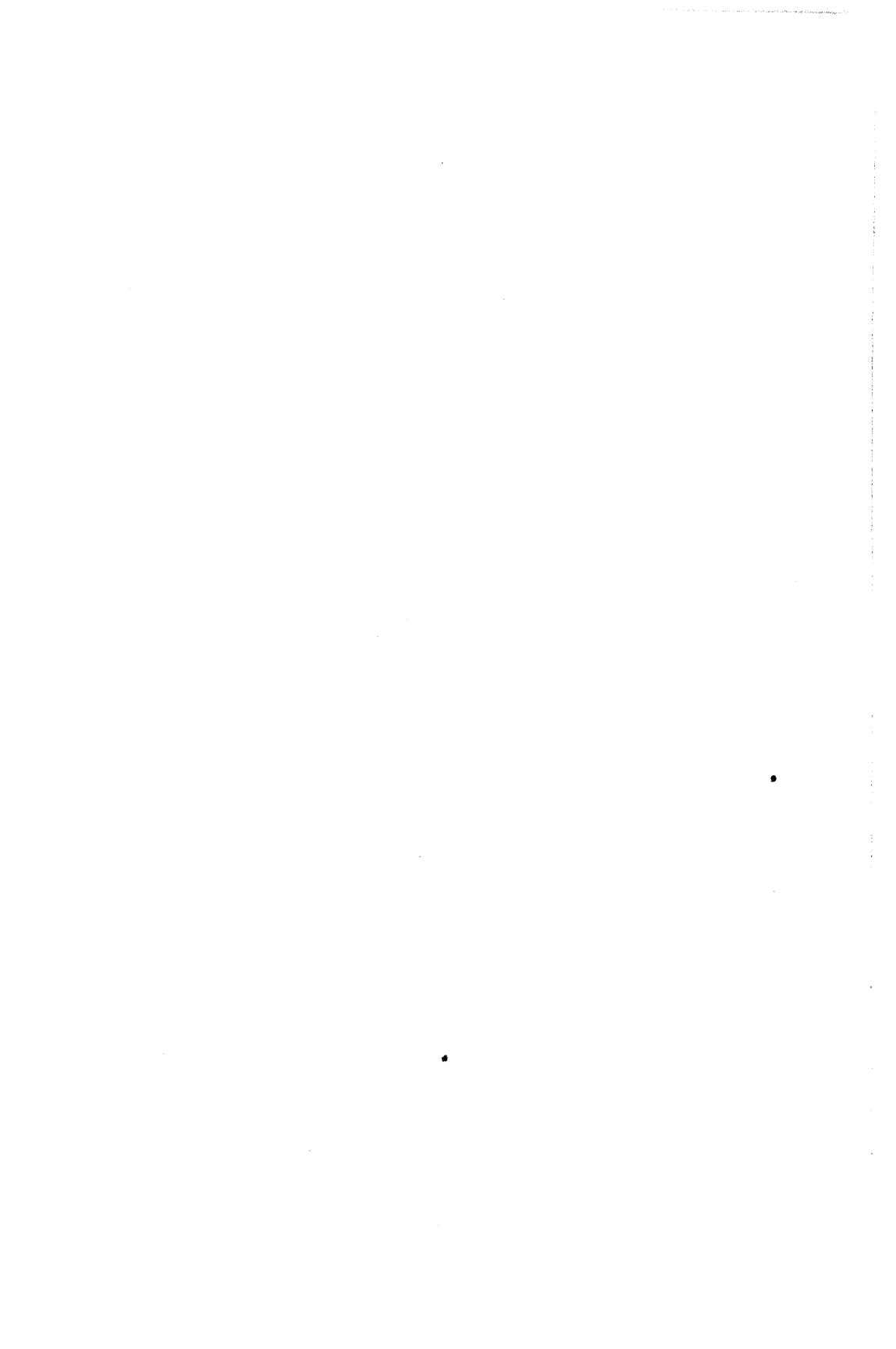
RESOLVE in favor of Cities and Towns in which was owned on the first day of April, 1887, capital stock of the Belfast and Moosehead Lake Railroad.
