STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section six of chapter one hundred and
eleven of the Revised Statutes relating to the Assignment
of Wages.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section six of chapter one hundred and
2 eleven is hereby amended so that said section shall read
3 as follows:

‘SECT. 6. No assignment of wages is valid against any
5 other person than the parties thereto, unless such assign-
6 ment is recorded by the clerk of the city, town or
7 plantation organized for any purpose in which the assignor
8 resides, if he has a residence within the State, otherwise

9 in the shire town of the county in which he is commorant
10 while earning such wages, and the clerk's fee shall be
11 twenty-five cents; and no such assignment of wages
12 whether so recorded or not shall be valid as against the
13 employer unless he has had actual notice thereof.'

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall not apply to any assignments of
2 wages already made.
