RESOLVE in favor of the Bangor Children's Home.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars per
2 annum for the years of A. D. 1892 and 1894 be and is
3 hereby appropriated in aid of the Bangor Children's Home,
4 to be paid by the State Treasurer from any funds not
5 otherwise appropriated.

BANGOR, Jan. 20, 1893.

To the Honorable Governor, Senate and House of Representatives of Maine:

The undersigned would respectfully represent that the Bangor Children's Home have more than fifty children under their charge from various towns in the eastern part of our State—some of them of soldiers.

Our income is not sufficient for their support, therefore we would ask from you one thousand dollars for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three and one thousand dollars for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, the same as has been granted to us the past twenty years or more.
