RESOLVE in favor of Town of Clinton.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of State,
2 out of the school funds of the current year, to the town of
3 Clinton, the sum of two hundred forty-five dollars and
4 ninety-two cents, it being a balance equitably due said
5 town as its proportion of the school funds for the year
6 eighteen hundred ninety-two.
