AN ACT to provide in part for the Expenditures of  
Government.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. In order to provide for the several acts and  
2 resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of money  
3 from the treasury, and also to provide for the necessary  
4 expenditures of government for the current fiscal year of  
5 eighteen hundred and ninety-three, the following sums  
6 are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury,  
7 and the governor, with the advice and consent of the coun-  
8 cil, is authorized at any time prior to the first day of Jan.  
9 next, to draw his warrant on the treasurer for the same.
