STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of trout from Jersey Pond
and outlet, and all tributaries to the said Pond and outlet,
located in Buckfield, Turner and Hartford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 taking trout from Jersey pond and outlet, and all tribu-
3 taries to the said pond and outlet, located in Buckfield,
4 Turner and Hartford, by any means, for four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars for the
3 offence, and a further penalty of one dollar for each trout
4 so taken, to be recovered on complaint before any trial
5 justice in any county where the offence is committed, one-

6 half to the complainant and one-half to the county where
7 the penalty is recovered.
