IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter eighteen of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended, so as to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 'Section 2. Being satisfied, that the petitioners are
- 5 responsible, and that an inquiry into the merits is expedi-
- 6 ent, they shall cause thirty days' notice to be given of the
- 7 time and place of their meeting, by posting copies of the
- 8 petition, with their order thereon, in three public places

- 9 in each town in which any part of the way is, and serving
- 10 one on the clerks of such towns, and publishing it in
- 11 some newspaper, if any, in the county. The fact that
- 12 notice has been so given, being proved and entered of
- 13 record, shall be sufficient for all interested, and evidence
- 14 thereof.'
 - SECT. 2. Chapter two hundred and fifty-nine of the
- 2 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine is hereby
- 3 repealed.
