## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT to aid in the Protection and Propagation of Fish.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Cities, towns and plantations are authorized  
2 to raise annually by a two-thirds vote at their annual  
3 meeting, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars, to be  
4 expended by the municipal officers thereof or by a com-  
5 missioner elected by the cities, towns or plantations for  
6 the propagation and protection of fish in public waters  
7 located wholly or partially within their respective limits.  
8 A report of the expenditures thereof shall be made at  
9 the next annual meeting by the officer or officers author-  
10 ized to expend such appropriation.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
