## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 281 of the Public laws of 1891, relating to Inland Fisheries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 281 of the Public Laws of 1891 2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Section 1. No landlocked salmon or trout shall be taken

- 4 by any person, in any way whatever from East, North,
- 5 McGraw, Ellis, Long, Great or Snow ponds, situated
- 6 in the counties of Kennebec and Somerset, or from
- 7 any streams flowing into or out of either of said ponds,
- 8 for a period of four years from the first day of May,
- 9 eighteen hundred and ninety-three.'
